



# Farm Girl Fingerless Mitts

*Knitting Pattern by Moth and Rust*

*These practical yet charming handwarmers were inspired by the yarn I used to create them; Brooklyn Tweed's Shelter in the Truffle Hunt colorway is richly rustic and perfect for these mitts. They have a very rural feeling, but are great for city folk, too.*

## **Materials:**

- 1 skein Shelter yarn by Brooklyn Tweed (or another worsted weight wool)
- 1 set of US 9 (5.5mm) double pointed needles
- Tapestry needle

## **Abbreviations:**

**CO** = cast on

**k** = knit

**p** = purl

**ssk** = slip one stitch, slip another, knit the two together

**mb** = knit into the front of the stitch, knit into the back, then knit into the front again, turn, knit 3 stitches, turn, purl 3 stitches together

**sts** = stitches

**k2tog** = knit 2 stitches together

**kfb** = knit into the front of the stitch, then into the back (increases by 1 stitch)

## **Instructions:**

*(Right Mitt)*

CO 28 sts onto 1 needle, work first five rows straight (not in the round):

Row 1-5: knit.

Distribute sts evenly over 3 needles; join round, careful not to twist. Proceed knitting in the round:

Round 1: knit.

Round 2: knit.

Round 3: ssk, k26. (27 sts)

Round 4: knit.

Round 5: ssk, k25. (26 sts)

Round 6: knit.



Round 7: ssk, k24. (25 sts)  
Round 8: knit.  
Round 9: ssk, k23. (24 sts)  
Round 10: mb, k23.  
Round 11: knit.  
Round 12: knit.  
Round 13: k6, kfb, knit to end. (25 sts)  
Round 14: knit.  
Round 15: knit.  
Round 16: k6, kfb, kfb, knit to end. (27 sts)  
Round 17-22: knit.  
Round 23: k5, p7, knit to end.  
Round 24: knit.  
Round 25: repeat Round 23.  
Round 26: knit.  
Round 27: repeat round 23.  
Round 28: knit.  
Round 29: k5, bring yarn to front and bind off 7 sts purlwise, bring yarn to back and knit to end.  
(20 sts)  
Round 30: k5, CO 4 sts, knit to end. (24 sts)  
Round 31: knit.  
Round 32: knit.  
Round 33: purl.  
Round 34: knit.  
Round 35: purl.  
Round 36: knit.  
Round 37: purl.

Bind off.

*(Left Mitt)*

CO 28 sts onto 1 needle, work first five rows straight (not in the round):

Row 1-5: knit.

Distribute sts evenly over 3 needles; join round, careful not to twist. Proceed knitting in the round:

Round 1: knit.  
Round 2: knit.  
Round 3: k26, k2tog. (27 sts)  
Round 4: knit.  
Round 5: k25, k2tog. (26 sts)  
Round 6: knit.  
Round 7: k24, k2tog. (25 sts)

Round 8: knit.  
Round 9: k23, k2tog. (24 sts)  
Round 10: k23, mb.  
Round 11: knit.  
Round 12: knit.  
Round 13: k16, kfb, knit to end. (25 sts)  
Round 14: knit.  
Round 15: knit.  
Round 16: k16, kfb, kfb, knit to end. (27 sts)  
Round 17-22: knit.  
Round 23: k15, p7, knit to end.  
Round 24: knit.  
Round 25: repeat round 23.  
Round 26: knit.  
Round 27: repeat round 23.  
Round 28: knit.  
Round 29: k15, bring yarn to front, BO 7 sts  
purlwise, bring yarn to back, knit to end. (20  
sts)  
Round 30: k15, CO 4 sts, knit to end. (24 sts)  
Round 31: knit.  
Round 32: knit.  
Round 33: purl.  
Round 34: knit.  
Round 35: purl.  
Round 36: knit.  
Round 37: purl.

Bind off, weave in ends.



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
