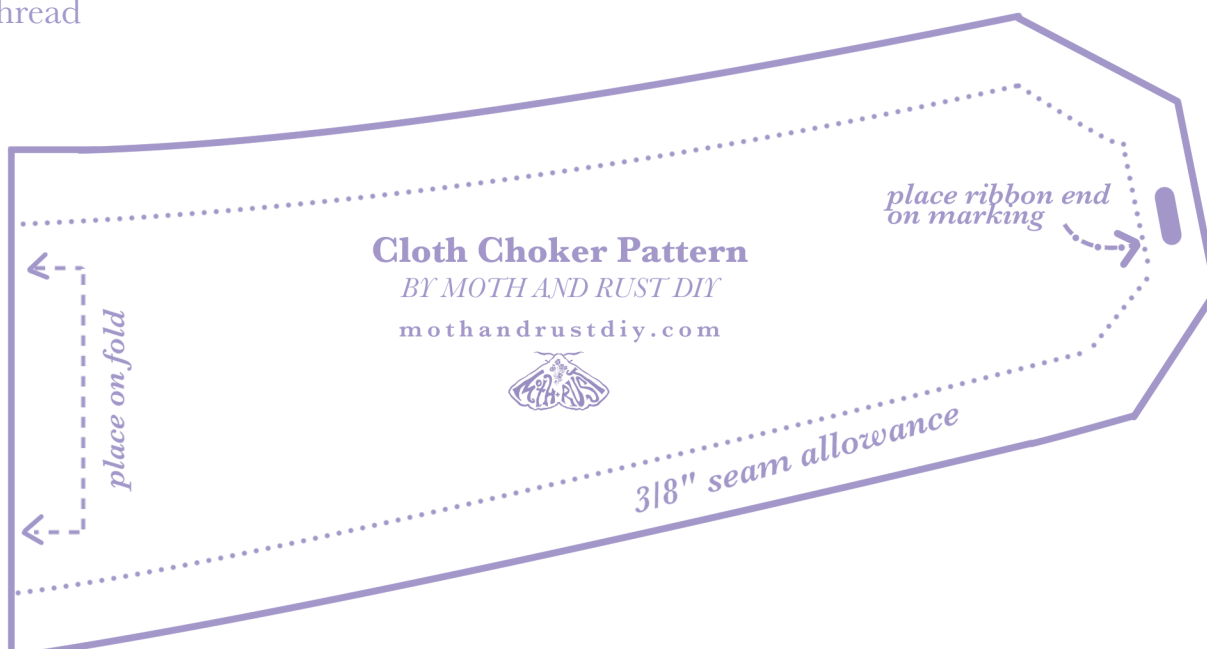


# CLOTH CHOKER PATTERN

## Materials Needed:

- Decorative fabric for outside
- Cotton fabric for lining
- About 30" ribbon or cord (cut into two 15" pieces)
- Lace, embroidery floss, or other embellishments
- Thread



## Directions:

1. Cut out pattern and place on fold of fabric where indicated; pin and cut around pattern. Do not cut edge placed on fold. Cut 1 outer piece and 1 lining piece.
2. Embellish the front piece of fabric as desired.
3. Tack ribbons/cord onto ends as indicated.
4. Pin lining to front, with right sides together, making sure ribbons are not caught in seams (except at ends). Stitch around using a 3/8" seam allowance, making sure to leave a 2"- 3" opening at the bottom.
5. Turn piece right side out, turn edges of opening under, and press.
6. Stitch hole closed with ladder stitch.
