

# Coquette Bloomer Drafting Worksheet

## My measurements:

\_\_\_\_\_ = (H) hips (fullest part) \_\_\_\_\_ = (L) distance from waistband to floor

\_\_\_\_\_ = waistband area (used when cutting drawstring or elastic)

### To Find Bloomer Measurements:

**A:**  $(H) \times 0.57 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

**B:**  $A + 4''$  to  $6'' =$  \_\_\_\_\_

**C (front seam):**  $(L) \times 0.28 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

**D (back seam):**  $(L) \times 0.32 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

### Leg ruffle length:

bottom of leg seam  $\times 2.5 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

### Hip ruffle length:

ruffle line on one side  $\times 5 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

**Waistband casing length:**  $A \times 2 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

**Waistband casing width:** depends on width of elastic or drawstring. One method to find this is:

$(\text{drawstring/elastic width} + 0.5'') \times 2 =$  \_\_\_\_\_

### Order of Construction

1. Cut out pieces & draw hip lines.
2. Sew ruffle pieces together.
3. Attach leg ruffles to leg opening.
4. Sew left and right bloomer pieces together at front and back seams.
5. Stitch crotch/inseam.
6. Hem leg ruffles, hem hip ruffles.
7. Sew hip ruffles along lines.
8. Attach waistband and add elastic or drawstring.
